“He Still Makes A Way!”

Increase your faith for the miracle you need by reflecting on the ones He’s already done!

Pharaoh sent for Moses and Aaron during the night. “Get out!” he ordered. “Leave my people—and take the rest of the Israelites with you! Go and worship the LORD as you have requested...” **The LORD caused the Egyptians to look favorably on the Israelites, and they gave the Israelites whatever they asked for. So they stripped the Egyptians of their wealth!**

– Exodus 12:31, 36 (NLT)

Don’t let fear rob you of your miracle!

But Moses told the people, “Don’t be afraid. Just stand still and watch the LORD rescue you today. The Egyptians you see today will never be seen again. **The LORD himself will fight for you. Just stay calm.**”
– Exodus 14:13-14 (NLT)

Your part is not the ONLY PART in the Great Story of God!

“Camp there along the shore...**I have planned this in order to display my glory through Pharaoh and his whole army. After this the Egyptians will know that I am the LORD!**”
– Exodus 14:2, 4 (NLT)

Sometimes the miracle is already in your hand!

Then the LORD said to Moses, “Why are you crying out to me? Tell the people to get moving! **Pick up your staff and raise your hand over the sea. Divide the water so the Israelites can walk through the middle of the sea on dry ground.**”
– Exodus 14:15-16 (NLT)

God’s not just working a miracle on your behalf; He’s working multiple miracles!

The cloud settled between the Egyptian and Israelite camps... The wind blew all that night, **turning the seabed into dry land.** So the people of Israel walked through the middle of the sea on dry ground, **with walls of water on each side!** Then the Egyptians—all of Pharaoh’s horses, chariots, and charioteers—chased them into the middle of the sea. But just before dawn the LORD looked down on the Egyptian army from the pillar of fire and cloud, and **he threw their forces into total confusion. He twisted their chariot wheels, making their chariots difficult to drive.**
