“He Still Forgives”

John 8:1-11 (NLT)

God’s not shocked by the things we do.

For he knows how weak we are; he remembers we are only dust. – Psalm 103:14 (NLT)

But Jesus didn’t trust them, because he knew all about people. No one needed to tell him about human nature, for he knew what was in each person’s heart.
– John 2:24-25 (NLT)

**We focus on the sin of others
rather than face the sin in ourselves.**

Do not judge others, and you will not be judged. **For you will be treated as you treat others. The standard you use in judging is the standard by which you will be judged.** – Matthew 7:1-2 (NLT)

Three mistakes we make in judging sin:

**We tend to judge sin that is action
rather than sin that is attitudinal!**

**We tend to judge the breaking of the commandments
of Moses but not the commandments of Jesus!**

**We judge others for their behavior,
but we judge ourselves by our intentions!**

**We are ALL deserving of death.
We are ALL undeserving candidates for grace!**

For everyone has sinned; we all fall short of God’s glorious standard...the wages of sin is death...
– Romans 3:23, 6:23 (NLT)

We are made right with God by placing our faith in Jesus Christ. **And this is true for everyone who believes, no matter who we are.** – Romans 3:22 (NLT)

**God doesn’t want to just give us a clean slate.
He wants to give us a NEW LIFE!**

Well then, should we keep on sinning so that God can show us more and more of his wonderful grace? **Of course not!...And just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glorious power of the Father, now we also may live new lives.** – Romans 6:1-2, 4 (NLT)
