**“Caring Like Jesus”**

But a Samaritan, as he journeyed, came to where he was (man who had been robbed and left for dead), and when he **saw him**, he **had compassion**. He **went to him** and **bound up his wounds**. – Luke 10:33-34 (ESV)

**Be Looking**  
**(saw him)**

Then the righteous will answer him, saying, ‘**Lord, when did we see you** hungry and feed you, or thirsty and give you drink? – Matthew 25:37 (ESV)

**Be Bothered**  
**(had compassion)**

Finally, all of you should be of one mind. **Sympathize with each other**. Love each other as brothers and sisters. **Be tenderhearted** and keep a humble attitude. – 1 Peter 3:8 (NLT)

The Spirit then compelled Jesus to go into the wilderness, where he was tempted by Satan for forty days. – Mark 1:12-13 (NLT)

**Be Present**  
**(went to him)**

Jesus Wept. – John 11:35 (ESV)

Do not be afraid, for I am with you. Do not be discouraged, **for I am your God**. I will strengthen you and help you. I will hold you up with my victorious right hand. – Isaiah 41:10 (NLT)

**Be Last**  
**(bound up his wounds)**

When he went ashore he **saw a great crowd, and he had compassion on them**, because they were like sheep without a shepherd. And he began to teach them many things. – Mark 6:34 (ESV)
